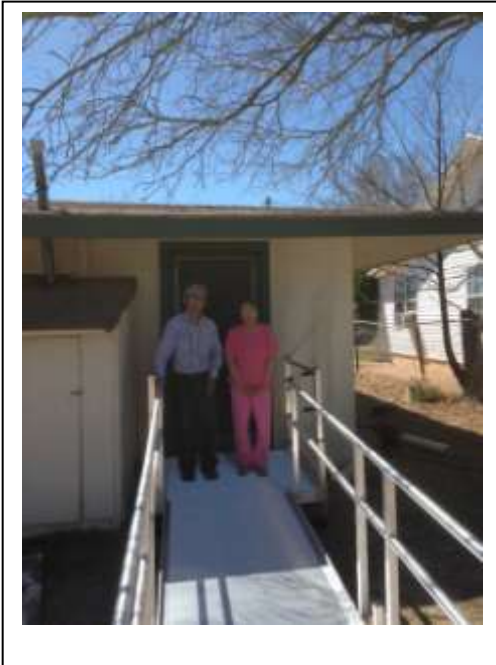


AMY YOUNG BARRIER REMOVAL PROGRAM

Program Details: Through the Texas Housing Trust Fund (HTF) the Amy Young Barrier Removal Program provides funds for home modifications necessary for accessibility and the elimination of hazardous conditions of low income home owners and renters. Galilee CDC works on homes in and around San Angelo.

Galilee will specifically provide assistance to individuals needing items such as handicapped-accessible showers, toilets, grab bars, widening of doorways and wheelchair ramps.

Eligible Household Beneficiaries: Persons with Disabilities at or below 80% Area Median Family Income (AMFI) who may be tenants or homeowners, and their household members with disabilities.



Eligible Activities: Barrier removal and health or safety hazard modification include, but not limited to:

- At least 75% of each home's total grant may be used for barrier removal.
- No more than 25% of each home's total grant may be used for health or safety hazard removal.
- The maximum expenditure per home is \$16,500.
- Persons with severe mobility concerns are given priority.
- This program funds will not be used to work on mobile homes.
