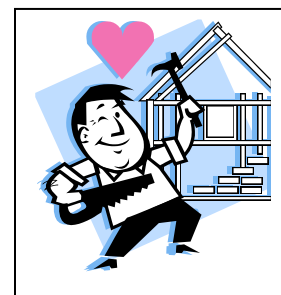


Volunteers

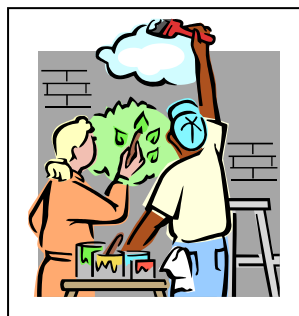
Our **Helping Hands** program provides light repairs for senior citizen home owners. We primarily use volunteers to do the light repairs. Most of our volunteers are needed in April. However, we have opportunity work days throughout the year for volunteers that can't work in April. During the summer/fall we work on 3 to 5 homes. Work can be done either during the week or on a weekend.

Opportunities

We need both skilled volunteers (mostly carpentry) and unskilled volunteers (painting and clean-up.) Children need to be over 14 years old and have parent's approval to help. We work on homes all around **Tom Green County and surrounding area**. Right now, we have a special need for teams to from Christoval and Bronte areas to work on near-by homes.



We have around 500 volunteers work on homes at our **April Blitz**. We begin recruiting volunteer teams as early as January for the April Blitz. **A team can be 5 to 20 people**. In 2015, **teams work on Saturday, April 11, 2015**. One person has to be the team captain. The team captain has to go to a couple meetings in February and March. Either skilled or unskilled volunteers can be team captains as long as they can organize their team.



Teams come from Goodfellow AFB, Angelo State University, churches, businesses and other community organizations. If you don't have an organization, but want to volunteer, we will find you a team. You don't have to have your team complete in March, but we want **Blitz volunteer team captains to sign-up by February 1st**.

We sometimes need volunteers to help build ramps. We work with **Texas Ramp Project** to build a couple ramps per year. It takes about one day for 5 people to install a ramp and a 2 hours a couple weeks later to come back and paint it.

GALILEE CDC holds two fundraisers per year. We use volunteers at the **Lone Wolf 5 Mile Run** on **Saturday, April 27, 2015** and at our **Fall Extravaganza Fundraiser**.
