

## Helping Hands

**Program Details:** Light repairs for low-income senior citizen homeowners in and around San Angelo. Making their homes Safe, Secure and Weatherproof with volunteers doing the repairs.

Typical repairs include: painting, caulking, weatherstripping, remove clutter, replace smoke alarms, ceiling fans, some sheetrock, replace toilets, installing grab bars and building ramps. Sometimes, we get additional grant funds to do more extensive repairs. Teams from GAFB, ASU, local churches and businesses form to work on houses on a one-day blitz. Individuals wanting to volunteer will be matched to a team that needs more workers. No special skills required to volunteer.

**Eligible Household Beneficiaries:** Homeowners at or below 80% Area Median Family Income (AMFI). Senior citizens are defined as over 60 y.o.

**Eligible Activities:** Barrier removal and health or safety hazard modification include, but not limited to:

- One weekend blitz per year in April
- Volunteer teams of 5 to 15 persons
- Typical repairs are under \$750 per house
- A few teams work on houses during the summer/fall
